Who We Are

*The **Canadian Valley Rangerettes** are an all women precision Equestrian Drill team established in 1969. We are comprised of riders ranging from 16 years and up. Our backgrounds vary from Homemakers to Police Officers, Skilled Professionals to Secretaries. We provide a colorful array of Cowgirls and horses when we perform our synchronized drill team maneuvers at rodeos and when we ride in parades. In 2009, we added an additional team The Canadian Valley Rangerette Youth. It is made up entirely of the children and grandchildren of our team members.*



Our Mission

Our mission is to encourage the participation of women who enjoy horseback riding and to promote the survival of mounted drill teams. We

are a family oriented organization dedicated to preserving the art of equestrian drill, while keeping the cowgirl spirit alive.

Why We Are Unique

The Rangerettes teams perform drill routines at local rodeos free of charge and participate in local parades to compete for prize money, which is used to maintain uniforms and equipment for the team. We are a non-profit organization performing just for the thrill. Each rider is responsible for their own horse, equipment, and transportation, and the club maintains a supply of uniforms and equipment.

Over the years, we have donated to the Canadian County Family Youth Services Program, End of the Trail, Bronco Saddle Club (special needs youth) and have helped many needy families during the holiday season. We practice weekly during the spring, summer and fall.

Our History

In 1968, the Mustang Round-Up Club (comprised of husbands and sons) participated in roping events while the women sat patiently watching from the bleachers. This high spirited group of Cowgirls grew anxious to ride and put on their own show! With hearts full of desire, they formed an all female drill team known then as The Mustang Round-Up Club Women's Drill Team. In 1969 the club members voted and changed the name to the Canadian Valley Rangerettes. The Rangerettes

performed publicly for the first time at Frontier City in August 1969. The Rangerettes have continued thrilling the crowds by performing at Professional Rodeo Cowboys Association (PRCA) rodeos and International Professional Rodeo Association (IPRA) Rodeos. It is this legacy and Cowgirl spirit that we want to keep alive!


